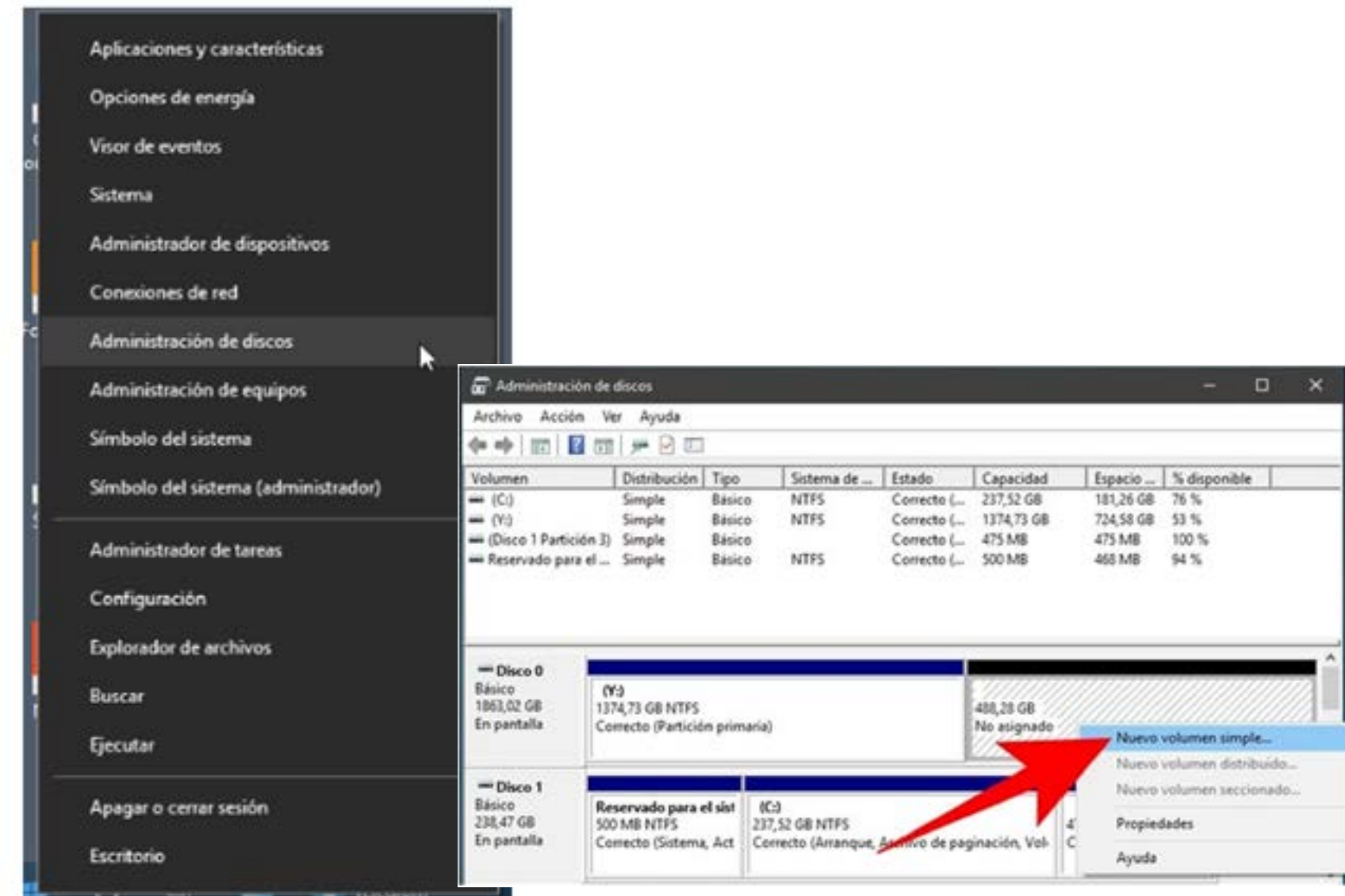
How it works

- Remove the top of the case through a small opening on one side.
- Place the silicone pad and, directly on top of it, the metal cover on the M.2 drive, and carefully insert the drive into the PCI-E port on the controller.
- Secure the drive with the rubber strap and close the device by fitting the top cover.



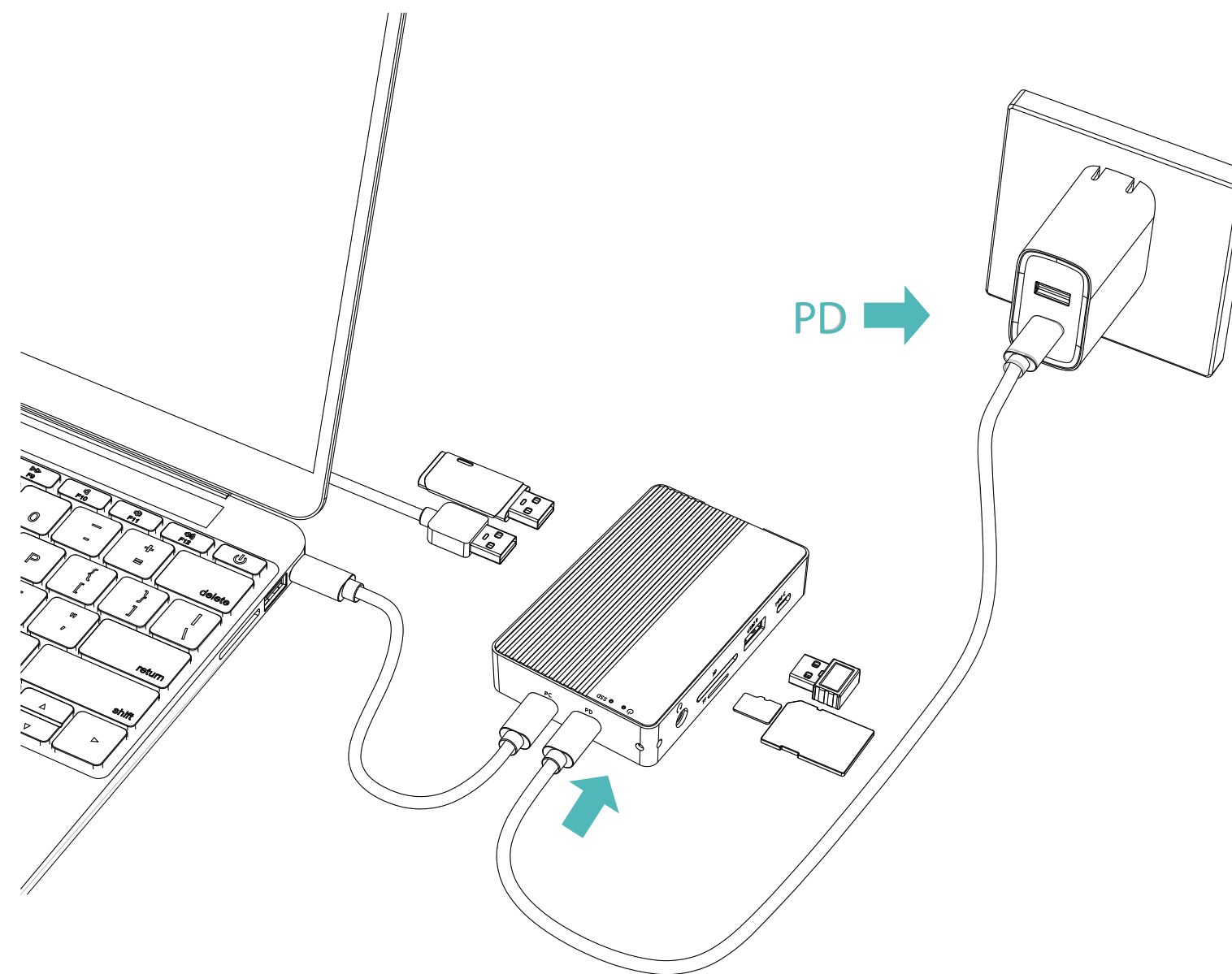
How it works

- Connect the device to the PC via USB-C without needing to install any drivers. Check that the drive has been detected correctly in Disk Management. Occasionally, if the drive is new and does not appear, it may need to be reformatted. For example, in Windows: Disk Management > Right-click on the drive > New Volume.



How peripherals work

- Connect the device via USB-C; the blue LED indicator will light up.
- Connect any TF/SD, USB-A, USB-C or jack peripherals to the device.
- Connect to the USB-C PD port using a power cable and mains adapter to charge the connected device if required (cable and adapter not included).





How HDMI work

- Connect the device to your PC via USB-C; the blue LED indicator will light up.
- Connect one end of an HDMI cable to the device and the other end to the monitor (cable not included).



Warranty information
